Our Charter

Brooklyn Prospect is a free public school that admits community students by lottery. As a charter school, we are granted flexibility in administrative procedure, school scheduling, curriculum design, and teacher development and retention. In exchange, we accept higher degrees of accountability.

In May of 2008, the State University of New York Board of Trustees authorized Brooklyn Prospect. We are the first community based New York City charter school to be approved by SUNY since 2005.



A Love of Learning

At Brooklyn Prospect, we are devoted to helping students discover their **academic passions**. Our teachers model the **life-long learning** that we hope to inspire in our students and provide the **challenge and support** necessary to ensure their success.

Our curriculum adopts the **International Baccalaureate** program's holistic approach to learning. This approach helps students make connections across subject areas and develop a vision of themselves as members of a global community. Our **advisory program** allows each student to meet daily with a faculty mentor in a small group to work on **literacy and study skills**.
